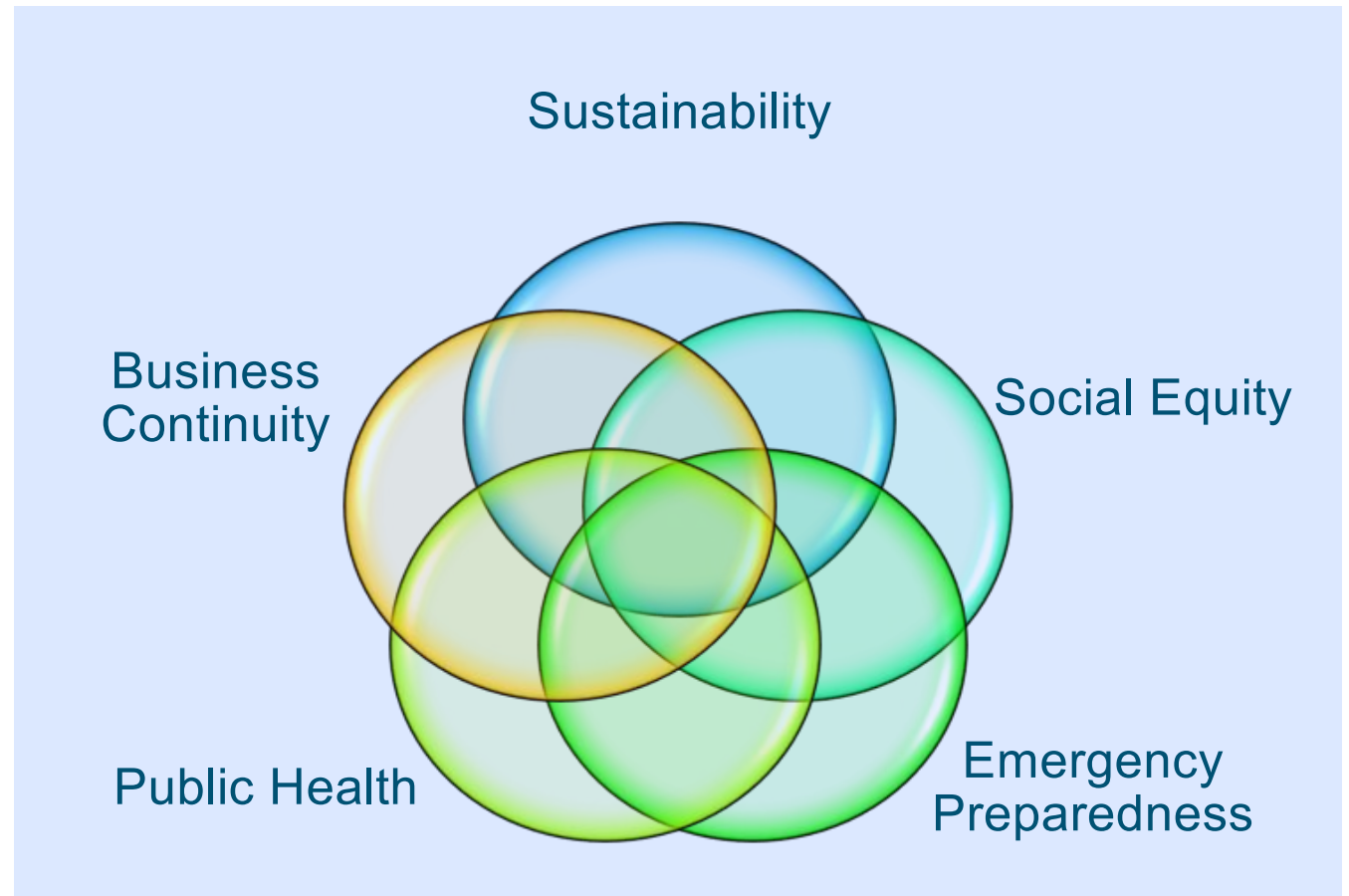

# Building Resilience-LA

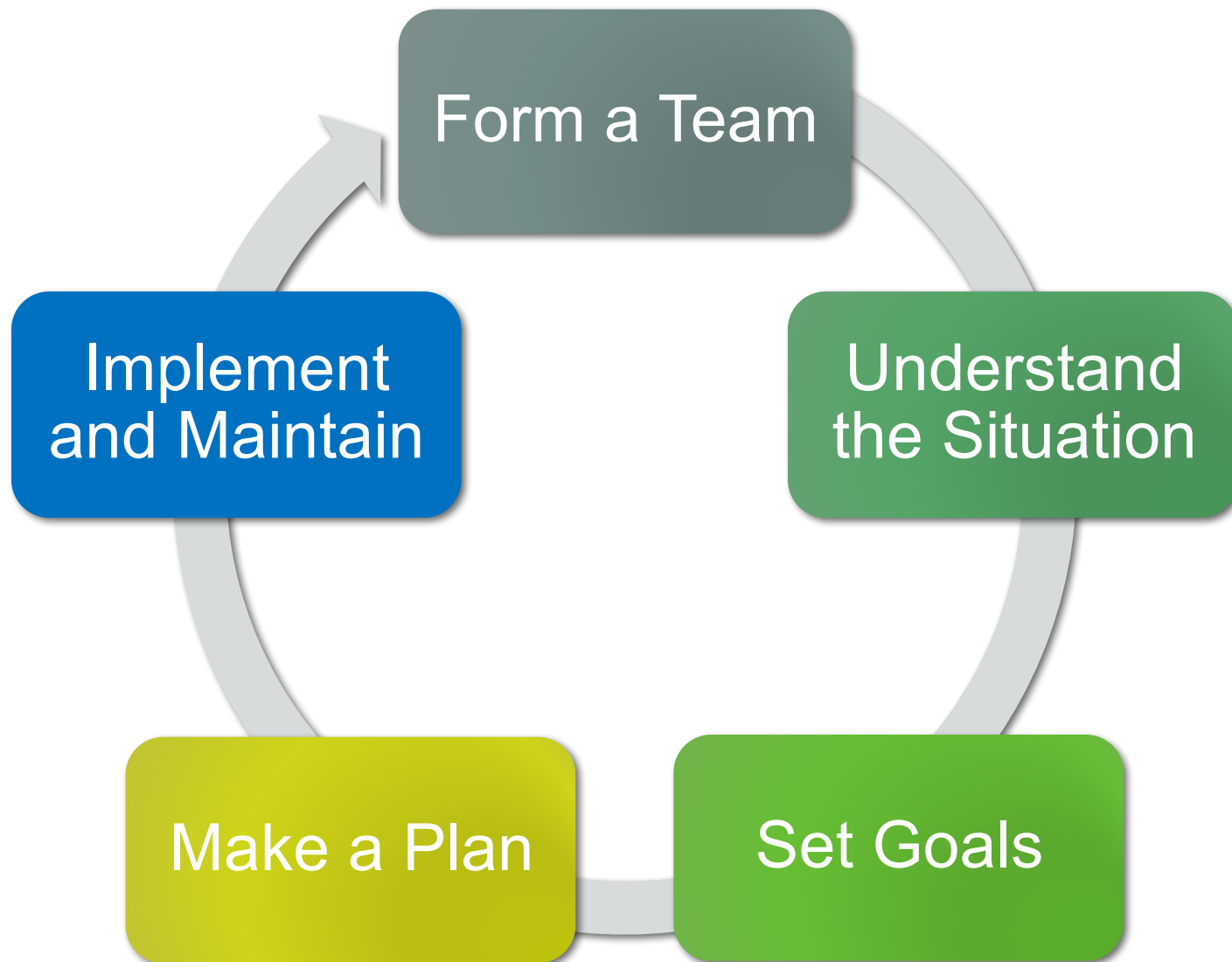
- This year:

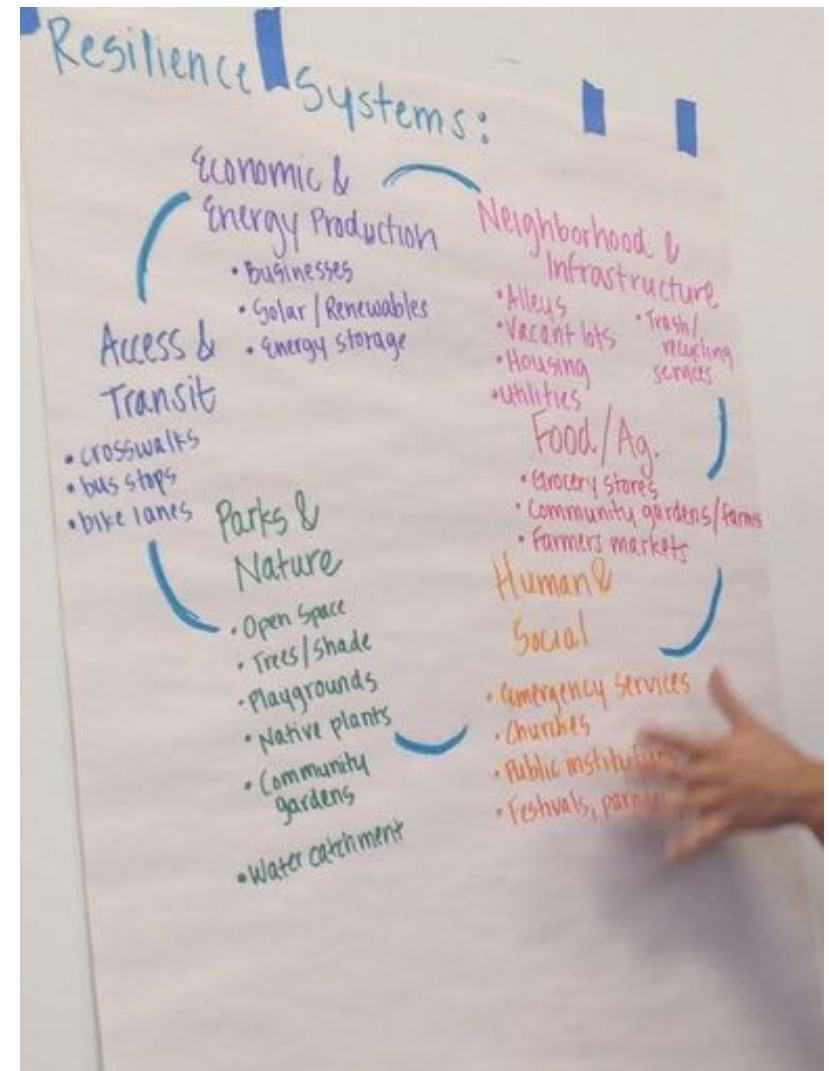


## Set Goals

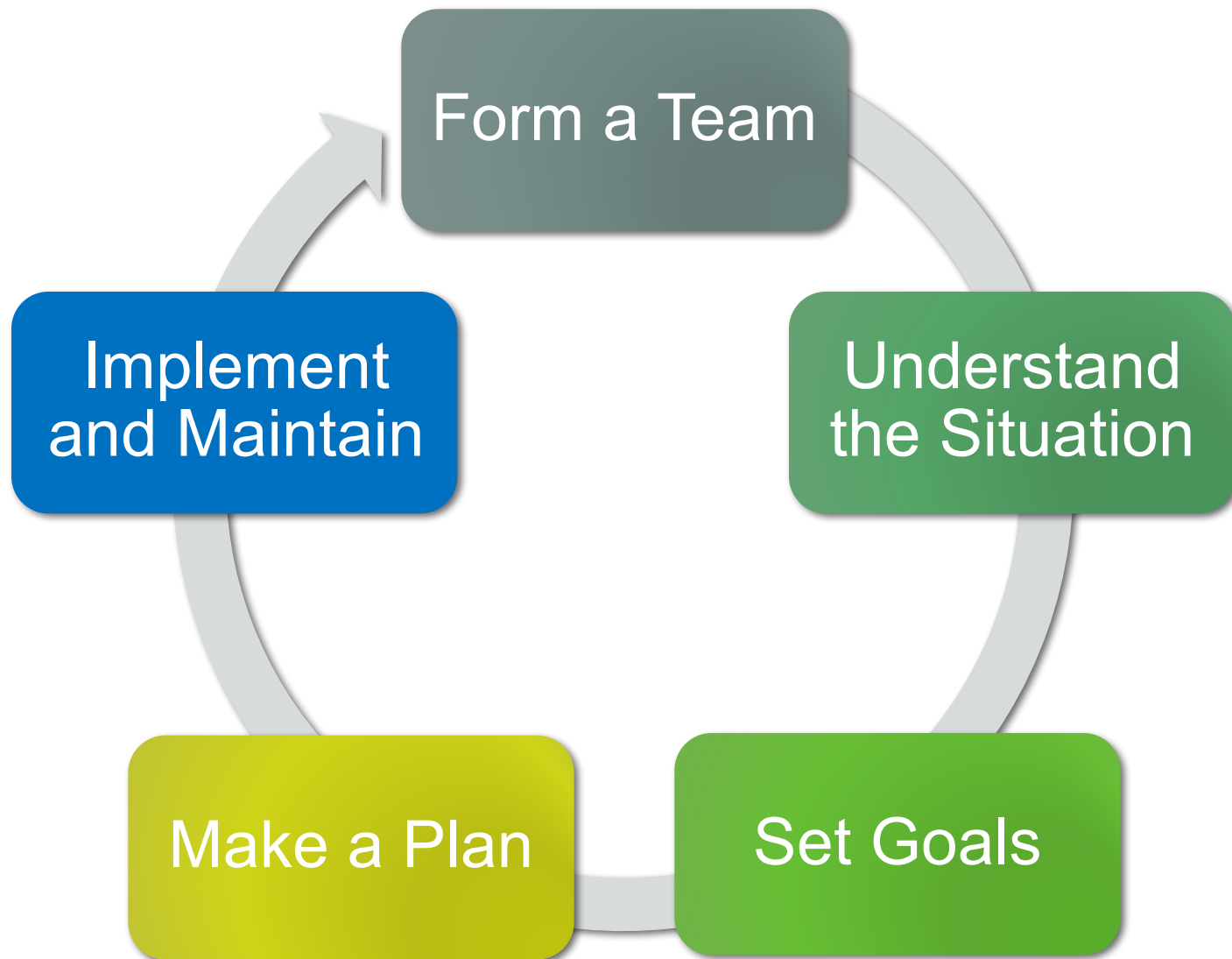
