Economic Prosperity in a Changing Climate

Work group goals:

- Demonstrate the importance of climate resilience as a critical part of economic development and health
- More fully integrate climate resilience into other community recovery, workforce, and economic development strategies



CLIMATE ACTION & ECONOMIC GROWTH HAVE HISTORICALLY BEEN SILOED


- Up until recently, investment programs did not connect sustainability and prosperity or encourage investment in clean energy
- There lacks a regional infrastructure and political will to connect economy/climate
- Climate advocates and economic development is siloed and often not in alignment

Historically, it was assumed climate action required sacrifice, but the economics have changed over the past 10 or 20 years.



- Occupational profiles are used as elements in Career Pathways which is a workforce development approach


THREE CORE FEATURES OF A CAREER PATHWAY


